
Seniors are busy making their post-secondary plans!

Naviance is a program we use to track our senior with their application process including: sending letters of recommendation, transcripts, and other documents needed from colleges.





HOW TO DOWNLOAD THE SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS AGENCY APP:


- 1. Go to the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android)

GCHS Students learn about energy conservation!

On Friday, November 17th teachers and staff cut our power usage by 23% as compared to the average of the previous 10 Fridays! Teachers did everything from turning off lights to having class outside all day! The office staff used desk lamps instead of the overhead fluorescent lights and un-plugged electronics that were not in

use! Even the kitchen staff got into this by turning off some of the lights in the lunchroom. This was a savings of over \$300 in energy costs. Here is the graph of our energy demand on the 17th compared to our average energy demand on the previous 10 Fridays.
