CFW WATERSHED FINALISTS (CARING FOR OUR WATERSHEDS)

Some of our GCHS students were asked to address the question, "What can I do to improve my Watershed?" in a 2,000-word essay plus a detailed budget that they submitted to the competition back in December. Out of 150 papers, theirs were chosen as one of the 10 best! All 10 finalists and 2 runner-ups were given up to \$1,000 to implement their projects. These students have been working on implementation since then and will now do a 5-minute presentation to a panel of judges who will then grill them with questions.

Award money starts at \$300 for 10th place and ends with \$1,000 going to the 1st place competitor! Please give them a major pat on the back as they have been powering through all of this in the midst of AP review sessions and tests, athletic events, arts magnet performances and so on.

Caring for our Watersheds

Over 300 proposals were submitting to the annual Caring for our Watershed Contest. Of those 300, five proposals from Greeley Central were chosen to be in the top ten or as an honorable mention. The top 10 proposals (3 of which were from Greeley Central) were given money to implement their proposal and had to present in front of a panel of judges. **Charles Cordova**, **Raeannon Alvarado**, and **Amalia Arrellano** were all honorable mentions.

Grace Patrick- The Last Straw, received **1st place** for her project which worked to reduce plastic straw use from restaurants in the Greeley. She collected straws from each restaurant and used them to make art pieces that they will display.

Gianna Uyemura- Lead with LED, received **2nd place** for her project which replaced the fluorescent lights in the science wing with LED bulbs, saving the school and the district money and helping lower the carbon footprint.

Greta Krombholz- The Bees Knees, received **5th place** for her project which focused on introducing native species of flowers that would increase the bee population by handing out packets of seeds with individualized artwork. Using art to encourage people to plant bee-friendly gardens.

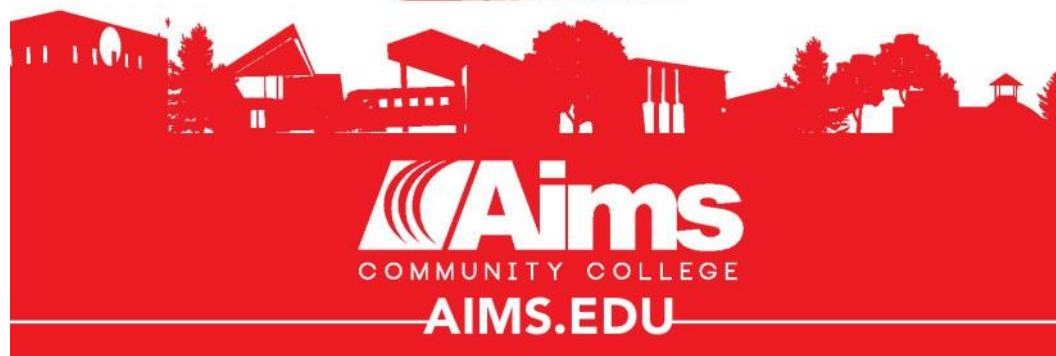

FALL SPORTS

Fall sports is just around the corner. Don't forget to check out the workout schedules listed in this newsletter as well as on the school's homepage.

Just as we have for the last few years, all sports registrations will be done online. There are no paper packets. However, the District has switched registration services and will no longer be using FamilyID to register students for sports. We will now be using rSchool to register all athletes. This service will be available mid-July and we will notify parents and guardians when this service will be activated and ready to register. Please note that this year there are different requirements from CHSAA, the governing body of Colorado sports, which will require registration through CHSAA as well. Instructions and school codes will be shared as that information becomes available.

All fall sports for the 2018-19 school year will start at the same time this year and will also start a week earlier than we did last year. **Fall sports will start**

on Monday, August 6th and we will have our **Fall Sports Night on**

Thursday, August 2nd. This Fall Sports Night will be a requirement for those wishing to participate in fall sports this year due to the changes in registration. Reminders will be sent out to all parents, guardians, and students as we get closer to this date.

A requirement is that the student has an up-to-date physical and that the student have insurance. Please don't wait until the last minute to get these items as it will cause your student to miss practices and unable to participate in sports.
