APES gives you a great opportunity to see thing you normally wouldn't see and gives you a different perspective on our environment and how it changes everyday.



There has been a total 18 shutdowns the last taking place in October 2013 during the Obama Administration. That had lasted 2 weeks and cost an estimated \$20 billion according to CNN Money. Soon after Negro Week celebrations and the studying of Black History started to spread around the world, but the idea of a month was not set into place until decades later. It wasn't until the mid-1960's when colleges and universities changed

that week into a month long celebration of black history. In 1976, President Gerald Ford decreed Black History Month as an national observance. Black

On the day of Sunday, January 14, 2018, David and Louise Turnip were arrested from their home in Perris California and are currently being held on a nine million dollar bail. The Turnip's were arrested and charged with accounts of torture and child endangerment when one of the thirteen children, a seventeen year old female crawled out the window and called 9-1-1 from a phone that was taken from inside. When police arrived, they found three of the girl's brothers and sisters chained and padlocked to their beds while the rest sat in the quiet, dark, foul smelling house. The Turnip parents only let their children shower once a year, taunted them with food, and abused them regularly. A former classmate of the eldest girl, Taha Muntajibuddin, shared his opinion, "It is nothing but sobering to know that the person who sat across from you at the lunch table went home to squalor and filth while you went home to a warm meal and a bedtime story." stated in a article Muntajibuddin wrote. The children ranging from two to twenty-nine are being treated by medical experts, seven of the thirteen are adults and are being treated at assisted living facilities according to CBS. Due to this sad event the siblings will not remain together and six of the youngest will be split between two foster homes. The Turnips will be due again in court on February 23, 2018.


