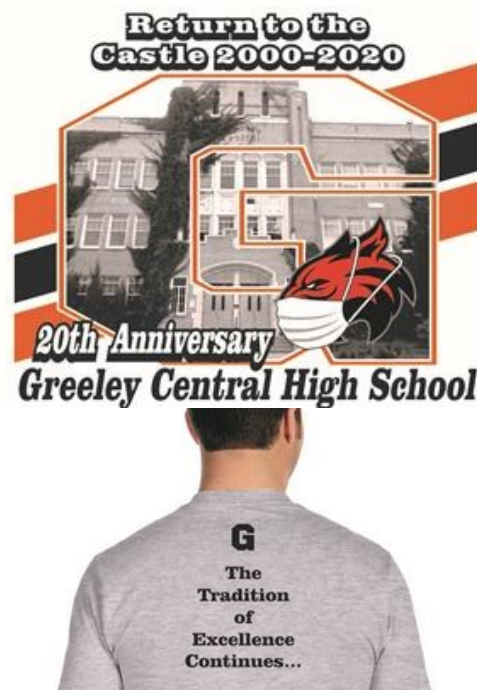

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## NOTES FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

### **Flu season is here:**

The CDC recommends that everyone 6 months and older get vaccinated this season.

Here are some other tips for staying healthy:

- Wash your hands with soap and water frequently during the flu season.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Cover your mouth or tuck it into your elbow when coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid contact with people who are sick. Don't share drinks or utensils with others.
- Stay home with fever over 100.5, chills, head and body aches, or uncontrollable cough.

### **As we begin to bring all students in-person, please help us continue contact tracing:**

- Please notify your school's health office if your child becomes ill or receives notification of a positive COVID-19 test during the 48 hours after their last day at school. Voice messages will be monitored during the remote learning period.
- If your child has been out of school on a quarantine, please notify your school's health office if your child becomes ill or receives notification of a positive COVID-19 test at any point during the quarantine period.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19 at any time during the remote learning period, please notify your school's health office.

### **Continue to practice recommended guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19:**

- Wear a mask when around any person outside of your immediate household. Wear a mask both indoors and outdoors. Anyone 11 years of age and older is mandated to wear a mask in public places; anyone between the ages of 3 and 11 years are strongly advised to wear a mask.

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds scrubbing all surfaces
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash, or use your inner elbow or sleeve
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
- Stay home if you are sick. Please!
- Get a flu shot! Everyone in the household should be vaccinated against influenza. It is not too late! Flu shots are available through your healthcare provider and at numerous pharmacies throughout the community.
- Clean high touch surfaces in your home and personal items such as cell phones using regular household products
- Practice social distancing, staying at least 6 feet away from others
- Socialize only with those in your household; if you must attend a gathering, limit the number of people to 10 and only from two households.

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## IN-PERSON LEARNING

We are back to our 100% in-person learning schedule for all students who have been using our hybrid learning schedule (those in Group A or Group B)! Please take note of our “no school days” & our adjustments for those weeks that have a modified school week (i.e., the week of April 12th).

- **April 7th** will be an asynchronous day (shaded in grey on calendar) for students. This means that teachers will **NOT** have video conferences (Zoom or Google Meet) for their classes. Students instead should check their Schoology folders for assignments in lieu of a video conference.
  - **For the week of April 12th**, due to SAT testing & PSAT testing, April 13th & 15th will both be asynchronous days (shaded in grey on calendar) where students not testing will work from home both days (**NOT IN-PERSON**) & will **not** have video conferences with their teachers. Students instead should check their Schoology folders for assignments in lieu of a video conference.
  - On **Tuesday, April 13th**, all 11th grade students will come to school in-person at 8am to take the SAT test. All 9th, 10th, & 12th grade students will work from home online & will need to check their Schoology folders for assignments for this day for attendance (no video conferences). **See page 8 for testing details.**
  - On **Wednesday, April 14th**, all students will be online learning from home as we normally do on Wednesdays. Students should log in to their Schoology and connect to their normal Wednesday video conferences (and possibly submit an assignment as well).
  - On **Thursday, April 15th**, all 9th & 10th grade students will come to school in-person at 8am to take the PSAT test. All 11th & 12th grade students will work from home & will need to check their Schoology folders for assignments for this day for attendance (no video conferences). **See page 8 for testing details.**
  - **NO SCHOOL on Friday, April 30th.**

### After School Tutoring

When we have no school on a Friday or a Monday (making only a 4-day school week), we may also add Wednesday to the list of after school tutoring. We will make an announcement during the day as to whether or not tutoring will occur on that Wednesday.



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## TESTING IN APRIL

We will be doing SAT and PSAT testing the week of April 12th here at Greeley Central. During these testing days, only students testing will be here at the school in-person. **All other students will be at home online.** Since teachers will be helping with these testing days, these testing days will be an asynchronous day for all students (this means there will be **NO video conferences with teachers**). Students not testing on these days (April 13th & 15th) should check their Schoology folders for each class for an assignment to complete. Please review the April calendar given on page 6 of this newsletter. Here are the dates for these upcoming tests:

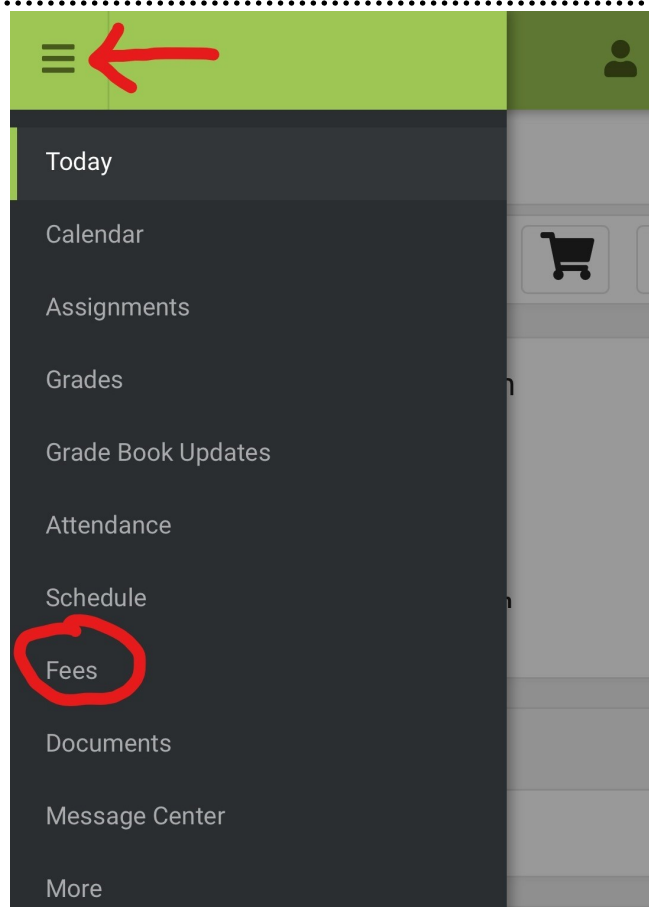
- **Tuesday, April 13th**
  - SAT Testing in-person for **ALL 11th grade students (online students as well)**
  - Arrive at the school no later than 8:00am\*\* (normal school start time)
  - Testing should finish around 12:00pm
  - Breakfast & Lunch will be available for 11th grade students this day
  - All other students should be home online (no video conferences but submit assignments)
- **Thursday, April 15th**
  - PSAT Testing in-person for ALL 9th & 10th grade students (**online students as well**)
  - Arrive at the school no later than 8:00am\*\* (normal school start time)
  - Testing should finish around 12:00pm
  - Breakfast & Lunch will be available for 9th & 10th grade students this day
  - All other students should be home online (no video conferences but submit assignments)

**\*\* Students who arrive later than 8:30am will NOT be allowed in for testing.**

## CHECKING FOR STUDENT FEES

As we get closer to the end of the school year, please start checking to see if your student may still owe any school fees. Although there may be items your student still has checked out (i.e., current season's uniform, current class's textbook, current Library book, etc.), there may be some items that have been posted to your student's fees from a previous quarter or a previous school year. Please check Infinite Campus (either through the Student portal or the Parent portal) to view these outstanding items. To view these items, once logged in to Infinite Campus:

- At the top left of the screen, click the menu icon (see the left red arrow in the picture to the right).
- Click the menu item labeled "**Fees**" (see the red circle in the picture to the right).
  - The default shows all "**Unpaid**" fees. If your student currently has fees due they will show up here.
  - To see what fees have been paid during this school year you can change the "**Type**" at the top right to "**Paid**". To view all fees incurred (paid & unpaid) for this school year, change the "**Type**" at the top right to "**All**".

## Sophomores:

Fourth quarter brings a lot of stress and anxiety around reaching the end of the year: reflecting on what you did well this year and what you would like to do better next year; setting up SMART goals for these last 6 weeks of school can ease your anxiety and give you a chance to put the last two years of high school into perspective. If you would like help developing these goals, please schedule a meeting with me, Mrs. Parsell.

If you did not go through registration, please see me to discuss the classes you would like to take next year. If you have questions about any of these classes or your plan of study, make an appointment with me (see link above).

If you have failed more than one or two classes, please see me as soon as you can to do a credit check and make a plan on how to recover these classes. There are a few options to do this but you must have a conversation with me to begin this recovery process.

PSAT, which all Sophomores will take, has been scheduled for April 15th. This first test should be used as a baseline score to give you a better understanding and idea on what you need to work on to increase your scores. Don't be too stressed over this test and remember it is just a practice exam to prepare you for the SAT used by colleges for admissions.

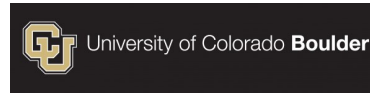

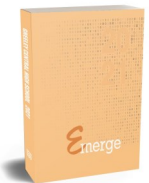

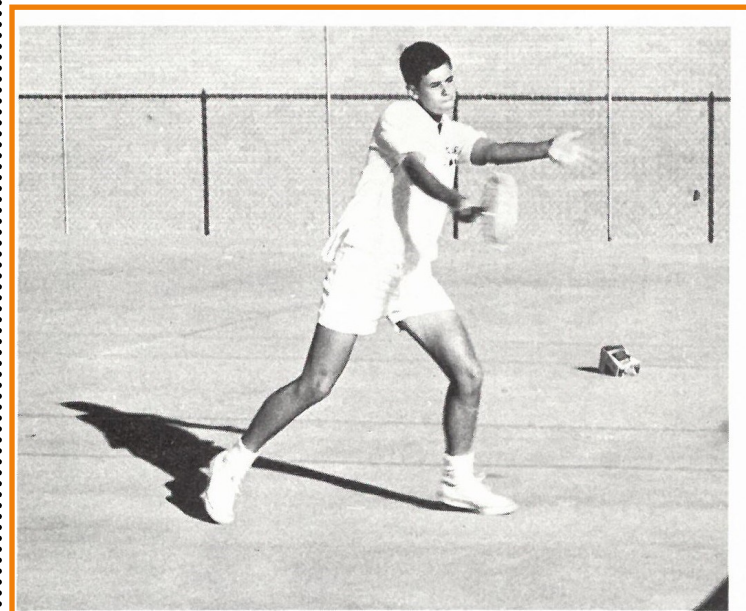
### WILDCAT SPECTATOR

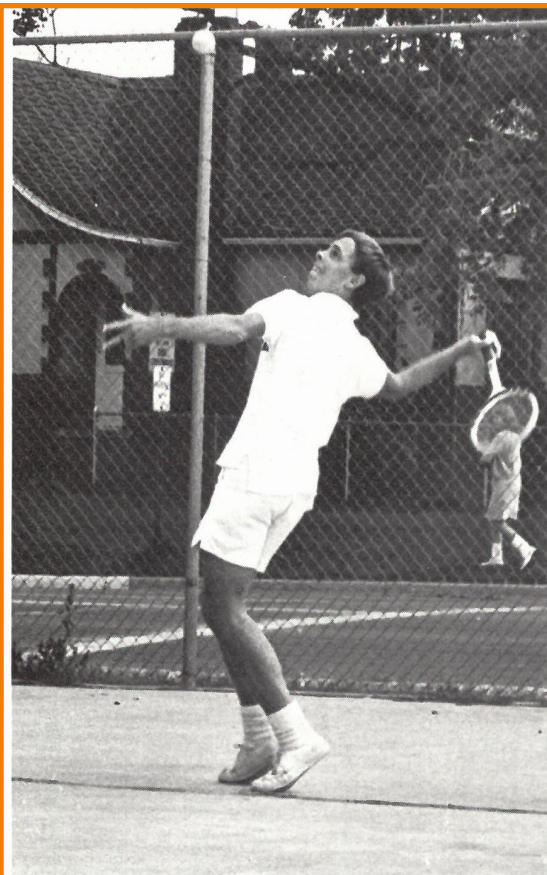


Long hours and hard work enabled Mark Stewart and his partner, Randy Elgin, to qualify for the State Tournament.

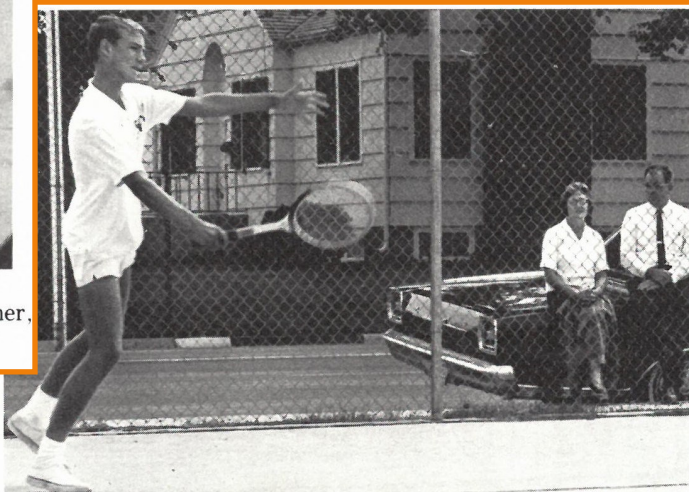

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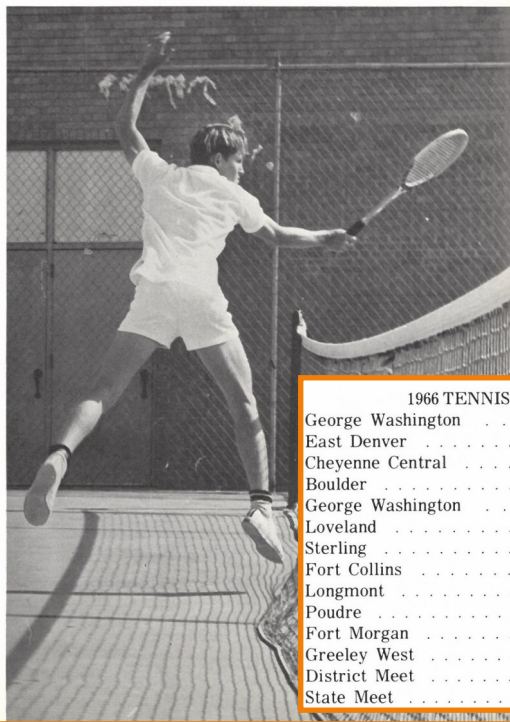
Wildcat's number one netter, Rick Wallace displays his winning style against Sterling's Larry Haas.



Rick Moore, Central's outstanding sophomore netter, delivers a powerful back hand stroke enroute to his straight set win over Tom Richert of Sterling.



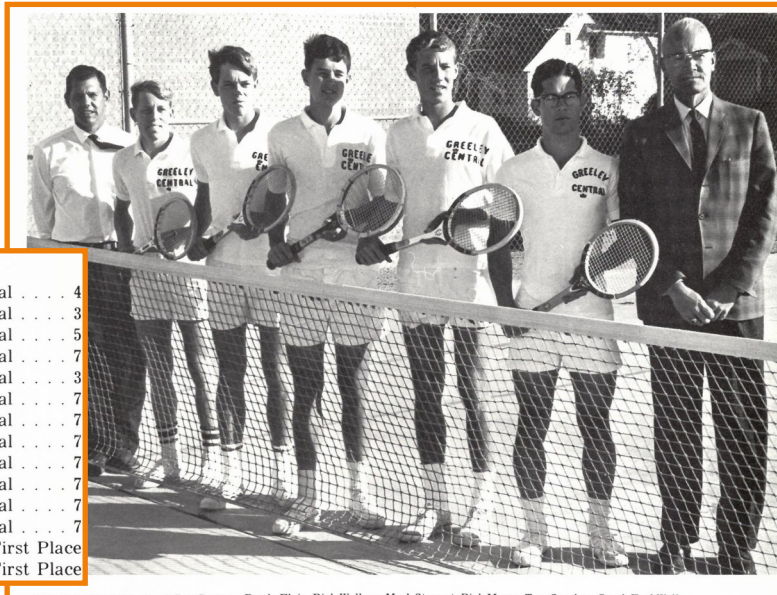
Randy Elgin returns a powerful shot to Don Blair in the match with Greeley West. In conference play, Randy had only three set points scored against him.
