School Meal Price Adjustment Approved

The District 6 Board of Education voted June 8 to raise the prices of school-prepared meals by a few cents for those who pay full price, effective at the beginning of the 2009-10 school year.

Director of nutrition services and procurement Mona Martinez-Brosh said her budget has been affected like everyone else's with the rise in food prices over the last several months, necessitating the price increase for school breakfast and lunches. She noted for the board that prices have not risen in the previous six years.

The price changes are:

Breakfast

Elementary: \$1.10 to \$1.25

Middle: \$1.10 to \$1.35

High: \$1.10 to \$1.50

Adult: \$1.50 to \$1.75

Lunch:

Elementary: \$1.75 to \$2.00

Middle: \$2.00 to \$2.25

High: \$2.25 to \$2.65

Adult: \$2.65 to \$3.00

Milk and juice purchased separate of meals is \$.65

There is no charge for reduced-price breakfast. Reduced-price lunch will remain at \$.40 for grades 3-12.
