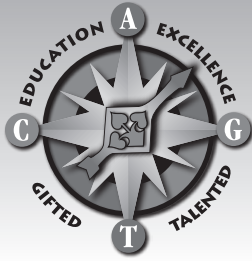


LEGISLATIVE DAY 2014 AT THE CAPITOL: CELEBRATING EXCELLENCE
