COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

Each of the nine grades at Harold S. Winograd K-8 School participates in community service projects or community service as a part of their Vision of COURAGE experience.

The fourth grade students ran the school store the week of Monday, April 4, 2016 through Friday, April 8, 2016. The proceeds from their sales will be used as their contribution to the Wild Animal Sanctuary located in Keenesburg, Colorado. This year’s donation will be \$205, enough to "adopt" a small animal (bobcat, lynx, fox, coyote, coati mundi, or raccoon) for \$120 for a year. If they can raise just \$35 more, they will be able to adopt a medium animal (leopard, mountain lion, or wolf). By adopting an animal they are contributing to the care of that animal for a year.
