GENTLE REMINDER

Why can't I skip my 20 minutes of reading tonight?

Student A reads 20 minutes five nights of every week.
Student B reads only 4 minutes a night. . .or not at all.

Student A reads 20 minutes x 5 times each week = 100 minutes/week.
Student B reads 4 minutes x 5 times each week = 20 minutes/week.

Student A reads 100 minutes x 4 weeks each month = 400 minutes/month.
Student B reads 20 minutes x 4 weeks each month = 80 minutes/month.

Student A reads 400 minutes x 9 months each school year = 3,600 minutes/year.
Student B reads 80 minutes x 9 months each school year = 720 minutes/year.

Student A practices reading the equivalent of ten whole school days a year.
Student B practices reading the equivalent of only two school days a year.

Which student would you expect to read better; know more; write better; have a better vocabulary; be more successful in school?

And, that is why you can't skip 20 minutes of reading tonight.
