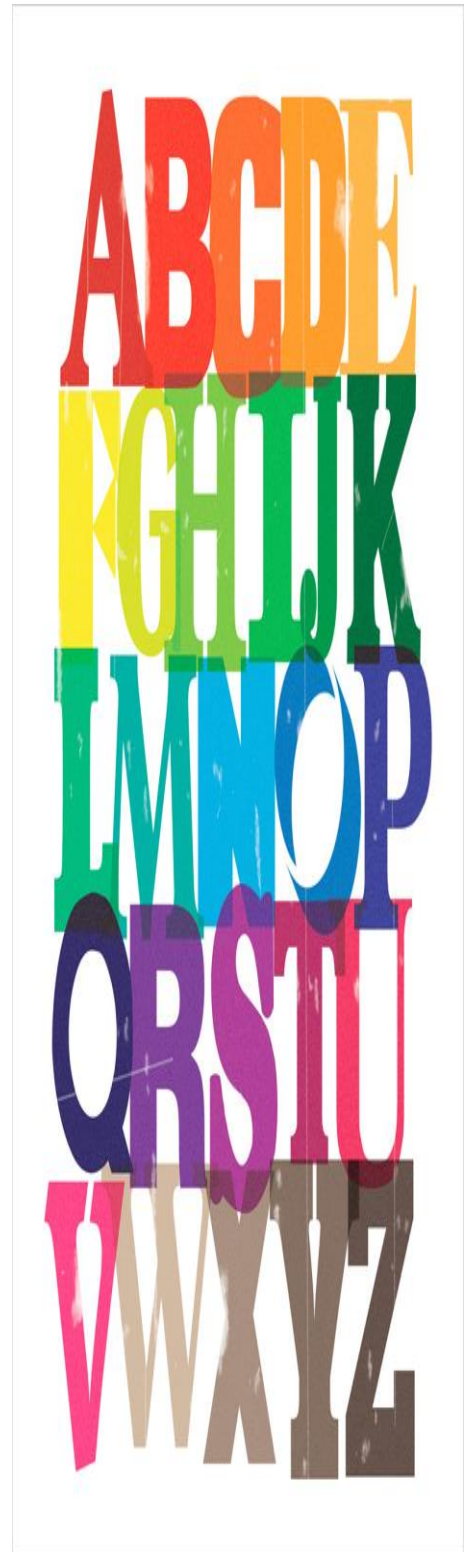


Dear Meeker Families,
