



**Each DAC is responsible for the following:**

1. **Recommending** to its local school board priorities for spending school district moneys;
2. **Submitting** recommendations to the local school board concerning preparation of the district's Performance, Improvement, Priority Improvement or Turnaround plan (whichever is applicable);
3. **Reviewing** any charter school applications received by the local school board and, if the local school board receives a charter school renewal application and upon request of the district and at the DAC's option, reviewing any renewal application prior to consideration by the local school board;
4. At least annually, cooperatively **determining**, with the local school board, the areas and issues, in addition to budget issues, that the DAC shall study and make recommendations upon;
5. At its option, meeting at least quarterly to **discuss** whether district leadership, personnel, and infrastructure are advancing or impeding implementation of the district's performance, improvement, priority improvement, or turnaround plan, whichever is applicable and,
6. **Providing** input and recommendations to the principals, on an advisory basis, concerning the development and use of assessment tools to measure and evaluate student academic growth as it relates to teacher evaluations;
7. For districts receiving ESEA funds, **consulting** with all required stakeholders with regard to federally funded activities.
8. **Publicizing** opportunities to serve and soliciting parents to serve on the DAC;
9. **Assisting** the district in implementing the district's family engagement policy; and
10. Assisting school personnel to increase families' engagement with educators, including families' engagement in creating students' READ plans, Individual Career and Academic Plans, and plans to address habitual truancy.
11. Local charge: Reviewing relevant data associated with the district's safe schools plan and making recommendations to the superintendent concerning the development and maintenance of the safe schools plan (Policy ADD)
