ADT270 Design Seminar

Recommended for: 9th and 10th grade.

This class covers the elements and principles of design as specifically related to fashion and interior design. The class allows students to explore each element and principle with a project and practice skill needed in fashion and design.

ADT650 and ADT651 Fashion Design 1 and

2

Recommended for: 10th, 11th, and 12th grade.

This class covers fashion design concepts including the history of fashion, sewing basics, apparel production, and other careers in the fashion industry. Semester 1 covers the needs of clothing and the elements of design.

Semester 2 focuses on clothing design, principles of design, and product creation.

Students should be enrolled in both semesters in the same school year if possible.

ADT260 and ADT261 Theater Costume Design (Only offered at Central)

Recommended for: 10th, 11th, and 12th grade.

This is a production class that specifically helps theater productions at the school. Semester 1 focuses on roles of costume designers and the design process. Semester 2 focuses on musical theater aspects and costume production.

Students should be enrolled in both semesters in the same school year if possible.
