### Prerequisites

### Program Requirements

- **New students must start in the fall semester.**

- Working knowledge of Computers and Electronics.
- **Students must receive a grade of “C” or better in each class in order to continue in the program.**

### Careers

- **Beginning broadcast technicians:** Assist broadcast technicians to set-up, operate, and maintain the electrical equipment for radio and television broadcasts, concerts, sound recordings, and movies.
- **Beginning on-air radio personalities:** Usually an overnight shift initially.
- **Beginning live sound reinforcement technicians:** Assist technicians to set-up, operate, and maintain the electrical equipment for concerts, meetings, and other large gatherings.
