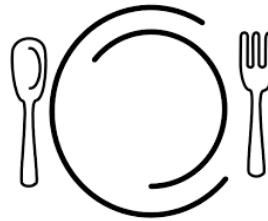

Colorado Health and Wellness Standards

Health and Wellness: The 21st Century program addresses Colorado's Health and Wellness Standards by implementing the Colorado Education Initiative's (CEI) Health Education Skills Model; Action-Based Learning labs for students in grades K-2; regular physical education activities such as organized sports and movement activities for students, and including the 4 Standards when developing projects for PBL. CEI's Health Education Skills Model is designed to support the implementation of Health Education Standards by helping students learn to access information, make decisions, and set goals related to their health and physical fitness.
