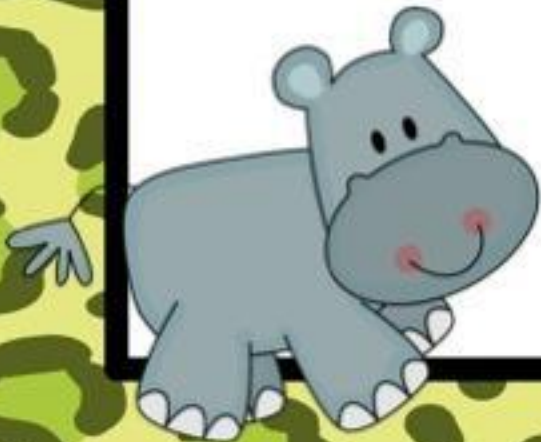

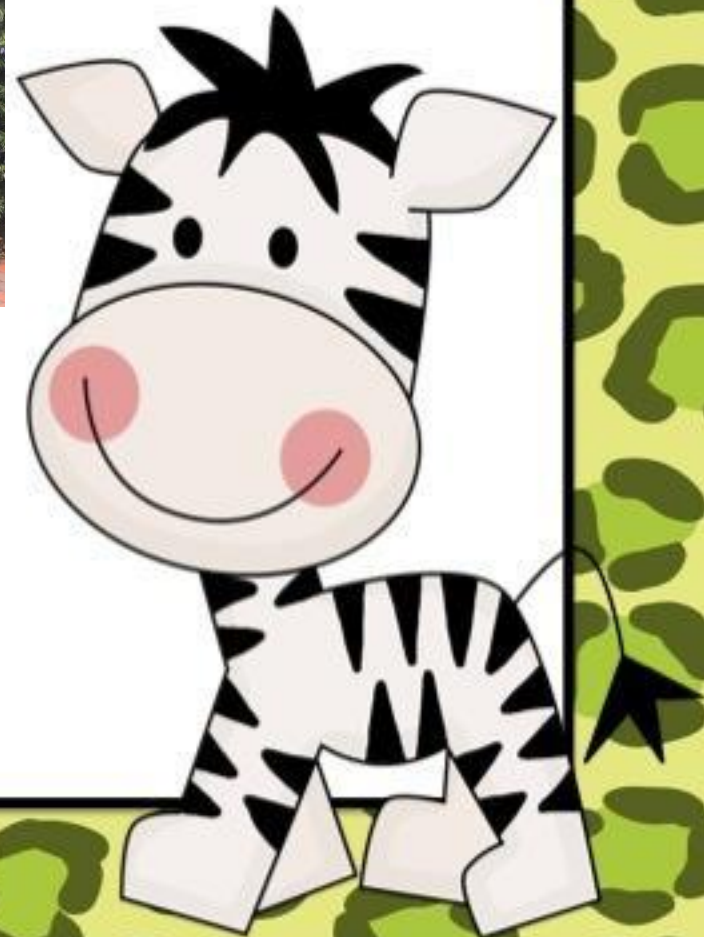

All homework is required to be completed and will be graded the following day.

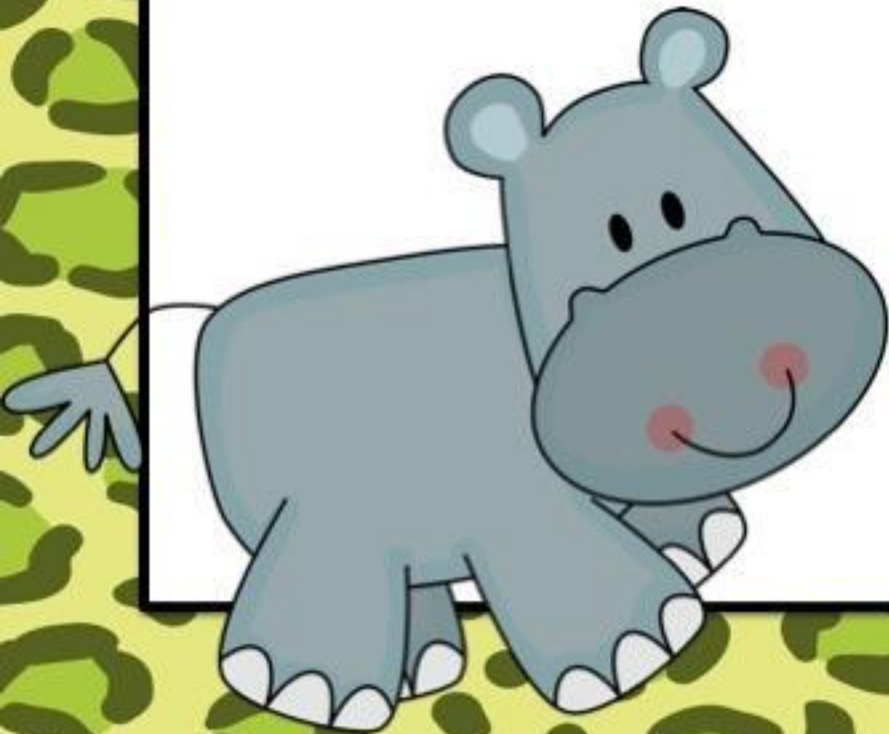
Attendance

Grading Policy

Grading system for report cards:

- 4- Student meets at a high level or succeeds grade level expectations.
- 3- Student meets most grade level expectations.
- 2- Student meets some grade level expectations.
- 1- Student works below grade level expectations.



Classroom Management System



I will also implement a color system clip chart within the classroom to ensure all students are being the best Trailblazers.

The clip chart consists of:

- **Blue "Wildly Good"** - Student has exceeded my expectations and has gone above and beyond.
- **Green "Ready for Adventure"** - Student meets my expectations.
- **Yellow "Monkeying Around"** - Student has received a warning.
- **Orange "Wrong Path"** - Student did not correct their behavior after the warning and will fill out a "Think It Through" sheet.
- **Red "Danger Zone"** - Student still did not correct their behavior and parent will be notified.

Rewards



I believe in focusing on the positives within my classroom, therefore, every student can earn privileges such as:

- a positive phone call/note/email home
 - treasure box prizes on Fridays
 - lunch with the teacher and much more.
- If your student is on either green or blue all week, they will get to choose a treasure from the box on Fridays!

Consequences

- **Green “Ready for Adventure”** - Student meets my expectations.
 - **Yellow “Monkeying Around”** - Student has received a warning.
 - **Orange “Wrong Path”** - Student did not correct their behavior after the warning and will fill out a “Think It Through” sheet.
 - **Red “Danger Zone”** - Student still did not correct their behavior and parent will be notified.



Consequences

Students have the opportunity to move back up to green or blue at any given time of the day. Unfortunately, if a student does end up on **Red** “**Danger Zone**” throughout the day, they will still be receiving a phone call or note home.

- If your student is on either **Yellow**, **Orange** or **Red** throughout the week, they will **Not** be able to receive the treasure box on Friday of that week.
