Grading Policy and Homework Club

In grades 6-8, students will be graded in two categories. Assessments/Projects (anything that assesses mastery of content) will be 70% of the grade and classwork/homework will be 30% of the grade. Students will be expected to complete every assignment and will be expected to correct work that is less than an 80%.

Homework Club will run Monday-Thursday from 3:20-4:00. This is for students that are missing assignments or need to correct assignments. It is mandatory that students attend. Students will notify their guardians if they are assigned. If your student cannot attend, guardians will be expected to excuse them via a phone call to the main office. Please plan to pick students up no later than 4:00. Homework Club will start August 28th.

Dress Code and Technology

This year, we will be enforcing the dress code. Students will not be allowed to wear clothing with inappropriate sayings/pictures, crop tops, or clothing that shows under garments. Students also should not be wearing hats or hoods in the building. If a student breaks dress code, the student will be asked to change. If they do not have another option, parents will be asked to bring additional clothing or pick them up. Please refer to the Parent Handbook for more information.

We have a no phone policy. Phones and airpods need to stay in backpacks throughout the day or be left at home. Students will be reminded in their first hour. If after first hour students have a device, it will be taken to the office. After the first time, parents will be notified.

Students are expected to bring a fully charged Chromebook each day!



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I.D. Policy

All middle school students will be expected to wear their ID around their necks all day. To ensure the safety of all students, they will not be allowed to leave their classroom without it. If a student loses their ID, they will be charged \$5.00 to have a new one printed. This will be charged to their student account.

Passing Periods and Bathroom Passes

Students will have 5 minutes to go from class to class. This is the ideal time to fill water bottles or use the restroom. If a student needs to use the restroom during class, they will be given 8 total bathroom passes for each quarter. They will need to utilize their school planner, teacher permission, and their ID to leave their classroom.

Soft Starts

School starts at 7:50, Tuesday through Friday. When they arrive, they can come in and eat breakfast in the cafeteria. After breakfast they must report directly to their advisement. Students will not be allowed to go back to the cafeteria once they have reported to advisement. Students can utilize this time to work on missing work, homework, or get support from their teachers. On Mondays, students can arrive at 8:50 and follow the same process.

Gum and Water Bottles

Gum is NOT allowed in our building. Please have students leave it at home. Students should also come with a water bottle with a closed lid. Students are only allowed water at school. Please do not send other drinks, as students will be asked to throw them away.
