KINDERGARTEN - 5TH GRADE STUDENTS

I see that attendance is taken only on Friday, why is that?

Every student in grades K-5 is required to have 2 conferences through Schoology with their teacher per week. This is reflected in attendance on Fridays. If a student misses just one check in, they will only be marked out on Fridays. If a student misses both check ins, they will be marked absent all week. Please know that these are REQUIRED check in's. If technology is an issue, please contact your students teacher to set up another form of communication.

What work is my student supposed to be doing?

- Reading: All students in grades K-5 are required to complete a minimum of 30 minutes on iReady

- Math: Students in grades kindergarten and 1st grade will complete 45 minutes of ST math
- Math: Students in grades 2 - 5 will complete 45 minutes of Zearn.

How will I know that my student is working?

During your students check in, their teacher will be able to tell you how much time they are working and how much content they are completing.

Help! ST Math is not saving my students progress! What are we doing wrong?

Progress is not saved in ST Math until you see the report which tells you how much your student completed. If you exit out without seeing this page, progress is not saved. If you are in the middle of a lesson and need to stop working, click the BACK ARROW until you get to the progress page and can exit out by clicking the 'X'. If you are having trouble with this, please contact your student's teacher.

MIDDLE GRADE STUDENTS 6-8

What is the expectation for remote learning?

The expectation during this time is that students are logging into their classes through Schoology, each class, each day. They need to be ON TIME and remain in the conference until they are dismissed by their teacher. Their teachers will guide them through a lesson and they are then to complete that day's assignment.

How is attendance being taken?

Students are required to log in their classes through Schoology each class, each day. Their teachers will guide them through a lesson and they are then to complete that day's assignment. If they are not able to log into Schoology, they MUST contact their teacher through email and complete that day's assignment by 5pm that day in order to be marked as present.

What if my student cannot attend a class or conference?

Contact the attendance secretary, Mrs. Vincent, at jvincent@greeleyschools.org if they are sick or have another reason for missing conferences and/or coursework. Any absences not communicated will be marked as unexcused.

How will I know that my student is working?

Grades will be recording through Infinite Campus. Parents are able to log in to their parent portal to see student grades. You can access this any time through McAuliffe's webpage or use the following link.
