Parent Teacher Conferences

The fall parent teacher conferences will be held on Monday, September 27th from 8:00am-5:00pm and Thursday, September 30th from 4:00-8:00 pm. The conferences will be offered virtually for the fall meetings. If an in-person conference is needed it must be scheduled with your child's teacher in advance. Per the district mask requirement for K-8 buildings, a mask must be worn while on our campus. Conference scheduling will occur with your child's classroom teacher(s).

Attendance and Class Assignments

Please review the following expectations as it pertains to attendance and class assignments during an absence.

1. Absence due to COVID-19 Quarantine

If your student(s) is absence due to a possible COVID exposure at school, please follow this process:

- After the 2nd day of quarantine, log into the Zoom links that will be provided by your students' teacher to join the classes virtually.
- Please contact your students' teacher by email or phone with any questions about this process or to check on required class work.

2. General Absence from School

If your student(s) is absence for any other reason from school (waiting for COVID results, ill, family matters, etc), then please follow this process:

- Notify the front office using the Attendance Line (970)348-1267

- Contact your students' teacher by email or phone with any questions about this process or to check on required class work.
- Students are given two days to make up work upon returning to school. During the absence period, students will need to access online materials provided by the classroom teacher.
