In response to school closures across Colorado, Rocky Mountain Public Media in partnership with the Office of the Governor, the Colorado Department of Education, and the Colorado Education Initiative, will provide K-3 learners, their families, and caregivers with direct-to-home remote literacy summer learning on broadcast and online! Starting May 18th, K-3 literacy lessons will be broadcast Monday-Friday from 8 am-10 am on Rocky Mountain PBS. Lessons will also be available for free streaming online at rmpbs.org/ColoradoClassroom and on the PBS Video App on smart devices (search "Colorado Classroom" in the app). Teacher-guided lessons will be broadcast in English with Spanish closed captioning.
