




the stage! Congratulations to all of the families who supported the Class of 2017!

2017.18 School Registration Packet Pick-up


Cards will be sent out soon with directions for picking up Registration packets for the 2017.18 school year. Packets may be picked up at the GCHS main office beginning July 31st and August 8th.

Student Registration Dates are:

Juniors: August 9th between 8:00 am - 11:00 am
Seniors: August 9th between 12:30 pm - 3:30 pm
Freshman: August 10th between 8:00 am - 11:00 am
Sophomores: August 10th between 12:30 pm - 3:30 pm

It is also extremely important for parents to check all information regarding addresses, phone numbers and email addresses to ensure that they are correct!

During registration, our school store will be open for you to purchase new GCHS gear. School photos will be taken at this time and from that you will receive a school ID, which will allow you to ride the GET bus service for FREE, just by showing them your ID. 2017.18 New Bell Schedule for GCHS

Although teachers will still begin their day at 7:15 am, students will have a new start time of 8:00 am. This is due to the movement from an 8 period day to a 7 period day. Achieving credits toward graduation will be more important than ever, because of this reduction in course opportunities in each semester. However, research has shown that an 8:00 am start time is best for teenage students.


Thursdays will also offer a new class called Seminar. This is a required course for all students in grades 9-12 at GCHS. Students will be enrolled into this time so that they will have opportunities to work with their

individual teachers. This time will be beneficial for students who require ongoing or periodic interventions in core academic, elective and AP courses. Unlike the previous intervention time built into the schedule, seminar will count as instructional time, students are required to attend, attendance will be taken, it will be credit/no-credit, and students will earn the credit at the end of the year. Seminar is also a time block where class meetings can take place, PSAT, SAT and AP pre-test administrative work can be completed, and the required components of the ICAP requirements (Individual Career and Academic Plan).

Bell Schedule

The 7 Period Modified Block Schedule is below. Every Monday, Tuesday and Friday students will have seven 55 minute periods. We will have a block schedule with an "Odd Day" on Wednesdays (Blocks 1,3,5,7) and an "Even Day" on Thursdays (Blocks 2,4,6). These classes are 95 minutes long. On Thursdays there is a 95 minute Seminar class before lunch. School staff will develop and communicate expectations regarding this time to all students at the beginning of each school year. Daily announcements occur during the second class of each day.


