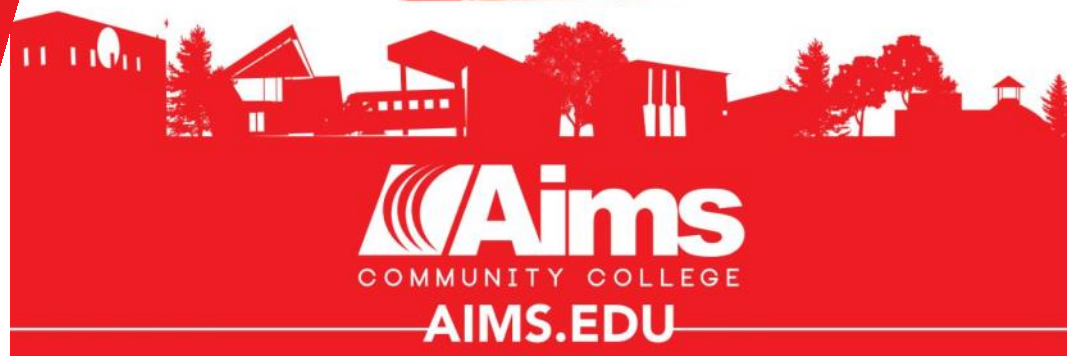
Don't forget to turn back your clocks for the end of Daylight Savings time at 2am on Sunday, November 4th.

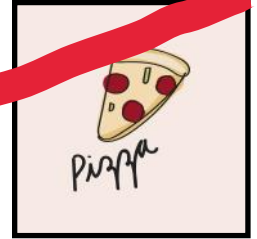

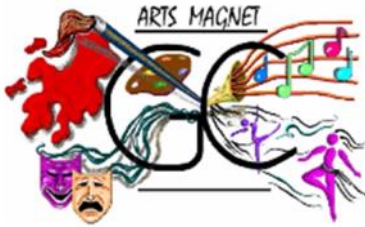
FUTURE BUSINESS LEADERS OF AMERICA- FBLA

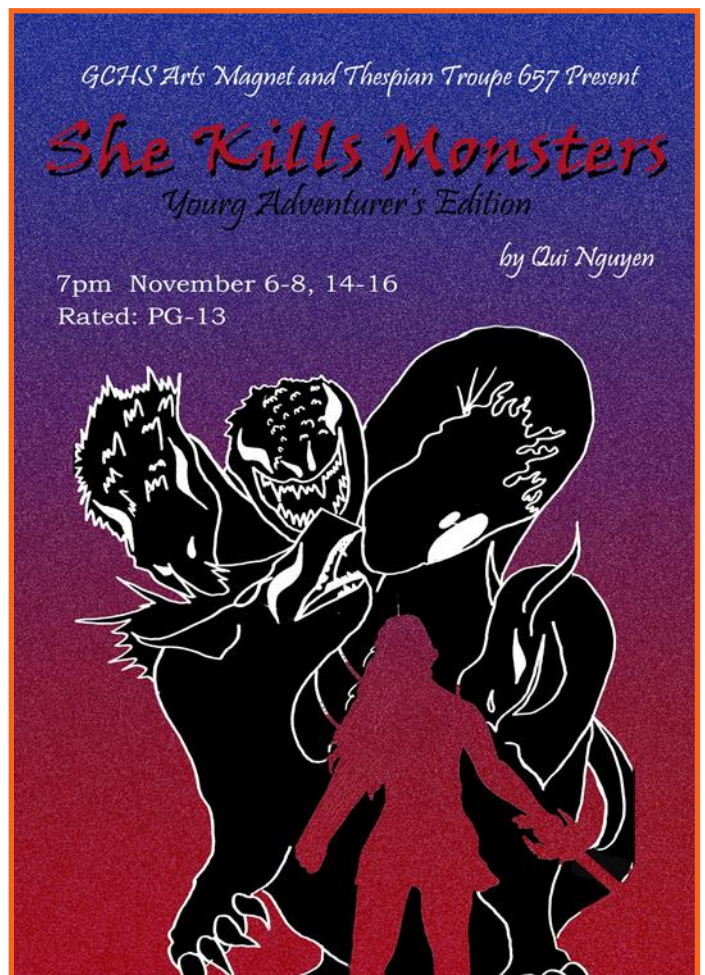

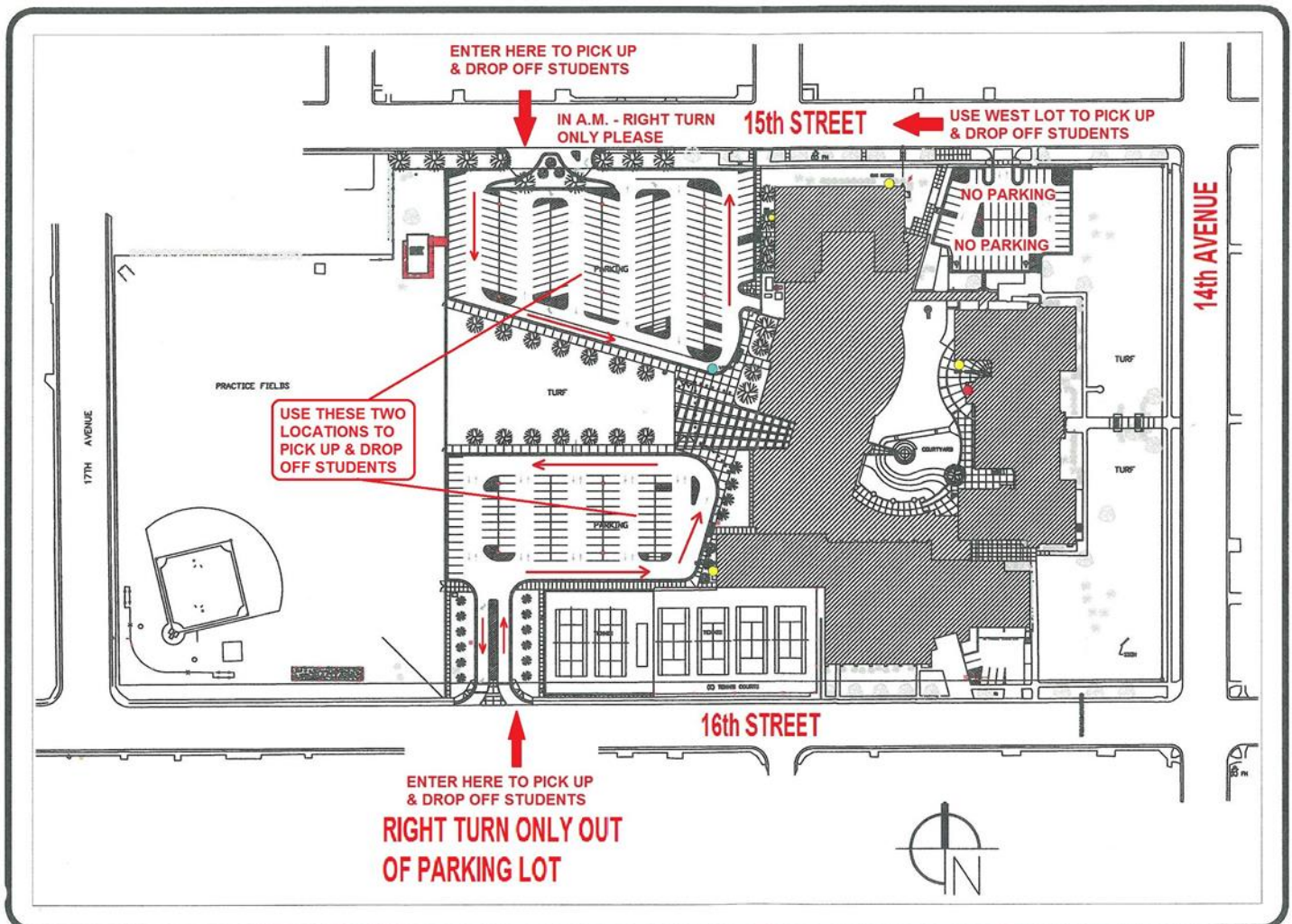
