Make sure all of your contact information as well as your insurance information and physical is up to date and not expired. If your student has already registered for a fall or winter sport, just log into the school site (see link above) and register your student for the next sport.

AP CLASSES


The next few months are an important time for our AP program at Greeley Central. It's hard to believe, but by the end of the month, discussions will begin about classes for the 2019-2020 school year! The lifeblood of our AP program is the simple act of students registering for an AP class. The 22+ AP classes that are offered at Greeley Central are made possible by students.

Taking an AP class is a great way to challenge yourself academically and show colleges that you are serious about your education. Since AP courses are rigorous and require you to study for a comprehensive exam, they teach you skills that will help you in college classes. According to College Board, students who take AP exams get higher grades in college than those with similar classes who don't take AP exams.

This year we offered the AP Capstone program. This is a diploma program from College Board designed to equip students with skills in research, teamwork, collaboration, and communication skills increasingly valued by colleges. To earn the AP Capstone diploma, students will take AP research, AP Seminar, 4 AP classes of their choice, and score a 3 or higher on each exam. AP seminar was offered this year for sophomores and juniors who want to pursue this prestigious opportunity.

AP TEST REGISTRATION

Students will register for AP exams mid-February in their AP classes. A student's signature to take the exam will insure one will be ordered. If a student signs up to take the exam, they have committed to a \$15 non-refundable fee per test. AP exams cost \$94 per test. The AP Capstone program, which includes AP Research & AP Seminar classes, has a different AP exam fee associated with them. The cost for each of these exams is \$142 per test. As with the other AP exams offered, the Capstone exams have a \$15 non-refundable fee per test.

Students that participate in the free and reduced lunch program are eligible to have test fees reduced *if a nutritional services letter for free and reduced lunch is turned in on or before March 15th*. The letter may be turned into Nancy Kern in the main office. Final AP test fee payments are due to the Greeley Central Finance Office by March 15th. See Nancy Kern with payment questions/concerns.

SAT WITH ESSAY TEST (JUNIORS)

ATTENTION ALL JUNIORS: This year the Colorado Department of Education has asked that we send out information concerning the optional **SAT with Essay** test. Some colleges may specifically require this test as a part of the admission process (we recommend that you confirm admission policies with your college of choice).

The Optional SAT with Essay in Colorado

11th-grade public school students in Colorado can add the SAT® with Essay to their SAT School Day registration for free. The Colorado Department of Education will cover all fees so you can take the SAT with Essay during the school day on April 9, 2019.

About the SAT with Essay

- The SAT with Essay will take approximately one hour longer than the SAT.
- It's your choice. You decide whether or not to take the SAT with Essay.
- The SAT Essay is scored separately from the SAT and does not impact your Evidence-Based Reading and Writing score.

Why Take the SAT with Essay?

The SAT Essay lets you practice your skills and gives you a chance to show colleges that you're ready for college-level writing assignments. Some colleges may specifically require it as a part of the admission process (we recommend that you confirm admission policies with your school of choice).

It's About the Real World

The SAT with Essay is a lot like a typical college writing assignment that asks you to analyze a text. It shows colleges you're ready to get to campus and write.

You'll have 50 minutes to:

- Read a passage
- Explain how the author builds an argument to persuade an audience
- Support your explanation with evidence from the passage

Register for the SAT with Essay

You can take the SAT with Essay at no additional cost. You must register between **January 15 and February 12, 2019.**

REGISTER ONLINE:

Register online before 10:00 p.m. Mountain Time (MT) on February 12, 2019, using your College Board account.

- 1 Go to sat.org and sign into your College Board account. If you've forgotten your username or password, click the link to recover them. Please do NOT create a new account. Once you're signed in, click on your username in the upper right-hand corner. Then select "My SAT."
- 2 If you do not have a College Board Account, go to sat.org and click "Register Now." Choose "Sign Up" and complete the required fields (name, sex, DOB, email address, expected HS graduation date) to create your account. Click "Continue" on the SAT Registration page. Review and complete the "Personal Info," "Your High School," and "Your Mailing Address" screens. You may be asked to provide "Your Previous Registration Number." Choose "Yes" and enter the registration number provided by your counselor.
- 3 Select "Change Registration" from the My SAT homepage. If you don't see your registration listed here, call customer service at 866-917-9030 for assistance.
- 4 Select "Add the essay to my registration" from the Change Your Registration page.
- 5 Once the "Add the essay to my registration" link is selected, a confirmation message will appear. Click "OK" to continue. Congratulations! You're registered for the SAT with Essay. If you decide later on that you would like to remove the essay from your registration, sign into your College Board account and select "Remove the essay from my registration" before **February 12, 2019**. Test day changes to add or remove the essay will not be allowed.

SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS

Most scholarships are due at the end of February so please look in the Senior Google Classroom to see upcoming scholarships or sign up to UNIGO to search for more.

If you haven't done any of these, please stop by the College Center in room 226 on Tuesday and Thursdays.

Parents: If your **senior** has not yet applied for the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), they should do so during ASAP. Scholarship applications began opening in January, and many schools will not process applications if the FAFSA isn't complete. Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov. You will need 2017 taxes for you and your senior (if applicable).



FAFSA is due March 1st.

We will have a FAFSA help night on Thursday, February 21st in the Greeley Central Library Lab from 5pm-8pm.

We will be having an **"I LOVE MY FUTURE DAY"** on February 14th. This will be an all day event where students will have the opportunity to finalize all post-secondary goals for the year.



BRIGHT FUTURES GRANT PROGRAM

The Bright Futures program was designed with one objective in mind—strengthening the vitality of the Weld County community through its workforce. By nurturing and supporting our young generation, we are building a strong foundation for a stable economy. Understanding the importance of trade skills as well as academic skills, the Board of Commissioners designed the program to financially assist students who pursue post-secondary education or training from an accredited higher-education institution or certified training program. The program is funded by taxpayers for qualifying Weld County residents who have graduated from high school, GED recipients and honorably discharged U.S. Veterans, after 2016. Qualified and accepted recipients receive financial assistance for pursuing post-secondary education or training from a Title IV accredited higher education institution or certified training program.

BRIGHT FUTURES


Residents of Weld County who graduate from high school or receive their high school equivalency may apply for the Bright Futures stipend. Students should talk with their school counselors for additional details.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

-  Annual amount a student can receive each year up to \$2,000.
-  Proof of Weld County residency.
-  Complete a Bright Futures application
-  Attend a meeting which will explain application process, requirements, and provide a highlight of local career opportunities and training that may be required in those careers.
-  Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
-  The stipend must begin within two years and completed within six years.
-  Move the stipend from "first dollar in" to "last dollar in". This means that the Bright Futures stipend will be applied in conjunction with all other scholarships or stipends instead of initially.
-  Require an annual 16 hours of community service in Weld County from each student in the program. Eight hours completed by June 30, and the other 8 hours by October 31. Hours may be completed early and combined with any community service hours required as part of graduation or other organization requirement (ie., Student Council, National Honor Society, Sports, etc.)
-  The stipend may be used to include only schools/institutions within Colorado and its bordering states that Bright Futures has or will have a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with.
