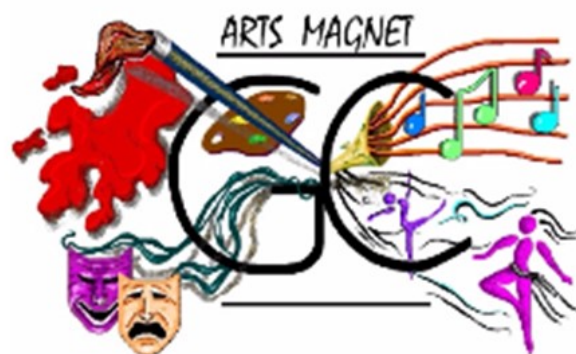



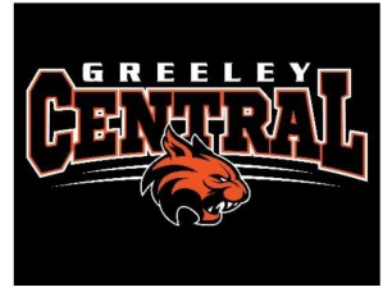

Student School Supply List

The following are typically necessary for high school classes:

- 3 ring binder
 - We suggest a 2" binder to accommodate the different classes taken
- College ruled notebook paper for 3-ring binders
- Blue or Black ink pens
- Pen/Pencil bag for 3-ring binders
- #2 lead pencils or mechanical pencils with #2 lead
- College ruled spiral notebook(s)
 - Either 1-subject for each class or 3 to 5 subject for multiple classes (recommend the type with perforations for clean removal from spiral)



The following may not be required but could be helpful:

- "Post-It" notes (1" or 3")
- 5-Tab or 8-Tab insertable page dividers for 3-ring binders
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 set of colored highlighters
- Black Shorts and White T-shirt
 - (ALL GCHS PE classes require students to wear black short and a white t-shirt)
- Scientific Calculator
 - (Pre-Algebra, Algebra B, Algebra I, Intermediate Algebra, Geometry, Physics)
- TI-84 Plus Graphing Calculator
 - (Algebra II, Trigonometry/Pre-Calculus, AP Statistics, AP Calculus)
- Geometry – Protractor, Compass
- Metric ruler

Are you taking a Science class?

- ALL Science students need (2) composition books (one for each semester)
- Students in AP Science classes should have a "scientific calculator" (one that include sine, cosine, and tangent functions) AND a 3-ring binder or designated space in a 3-ring binder
