Registering for Athletics

1. Register online using the rSchool link on the Winograd Athletics Homepage.
2. Physicals need to be updated yearly. You can either submit the physical on rSchool or you can turn in a hard copy to the front office.
 - a. Athletes will NOT be allowed to practice without an updated physical.
3. Registration fee for WINOGRAD ATHLETICS can be paid through rSchool or cash/check can be delivered to the front office.
 - a. Checks need to be addressed to Winograd K-8
4. No students will be able to join the team after *Friday, August 23rd, 2019*

Participation

- **Volleyball**
 - First day of practice is Wednesday, August 21st, 2019
 - Volleyball try-outs will occur from Thursday, August 15th-Tuesday, August 20th
 - Volleyball is a no-cut sport; all athletes will be invited to join a team
- **Swimming**
 - First day of practice is Tuesday Aug. 20, 2019
 - Practice will be Tuesday-Friday from 4:00-5:15 pm at the Greeley Rec Center
 - You are responsible for finding transportation to practice; there will be a bus provided for meets
- **Cross Country**
 - First day of practice Tuesday Aug. 20, 2019
 - Practice will be Tuesday-Friday from 3:10-4:20 pm
- **Game/meet days vary by sport**
 - Times may vary; refer to the website for specific times, days, and locations
- **Coaches must be contacted if the student is absent or will miss practice**
 - Excessive unexcused absences may result in removal from the team
- **All athletes must be picked up within 30 minutes of the end of a practice or a game**
 - Please, for your child's safety, do not leave them waiting at school
 - Habitual lateness may result in your student being suspended from a game
- **All school rules apply for student athletes at practices and games**
 - Follow the coach's directions at all times
 - No student visitors at practice
- **All athletes must be eligible to play in games and tournaments**
 - To be eligible, athletes must have no more than one "F"
 - Athletes are expected to be at practice when ineligible
 - Ineligibility is for the entire week, Monday through Saturday, even if the grade changes to passing within that week

Sportsmanship
