As of Thursday, October 15, 2020 there will be three Cross Country Running meets. The schools that will be participating in these meets are Bella Romero, Brentwood Middle School, McAuliffe K-8 STEM Academy, Prairie Heights Middle School, and Harold S. Winograd K-8 School. The first meet will be hosted by Brentwood Middle School and will take place at Josephine B. Jones Park on Friday, October 23, 2020. The second meet will be hosted by McAuliffe K-8 STEM Academy and will take place at Monfort Park on Tuesday, October 27, 2020. The culminating meet will be hosted by Harold S. Winograd K-8 School and will take place at Harold S. Winograd K-8 School on Friday, October 30, 2020. Since this is a running club, there will not be ribbons or trophies given at the meets. However, times will be taken and shared with coaches and athletes. All meets will begin promptly at 3:30 PM. Transportation to each meet will be provided but students will need to get their own rides home once the meet is finished. In order to keep our athletes and families safe, all attendees must wear a mask at all times. Athletes will be allowed to remove their mask at the start of the race and need to put their mask back on once they cross the finish line. All spectators must also remain 6 feet apart from other non-family spectators. Each athlete will receive two tickets for family members. Please do not bring any more than two family members to each meet. If the Cross Country Running Club meets are successful, there is a greater likelihood that other sports will become available to our students later in the school year. Your help is appreciated!!!
