How are mummies made?

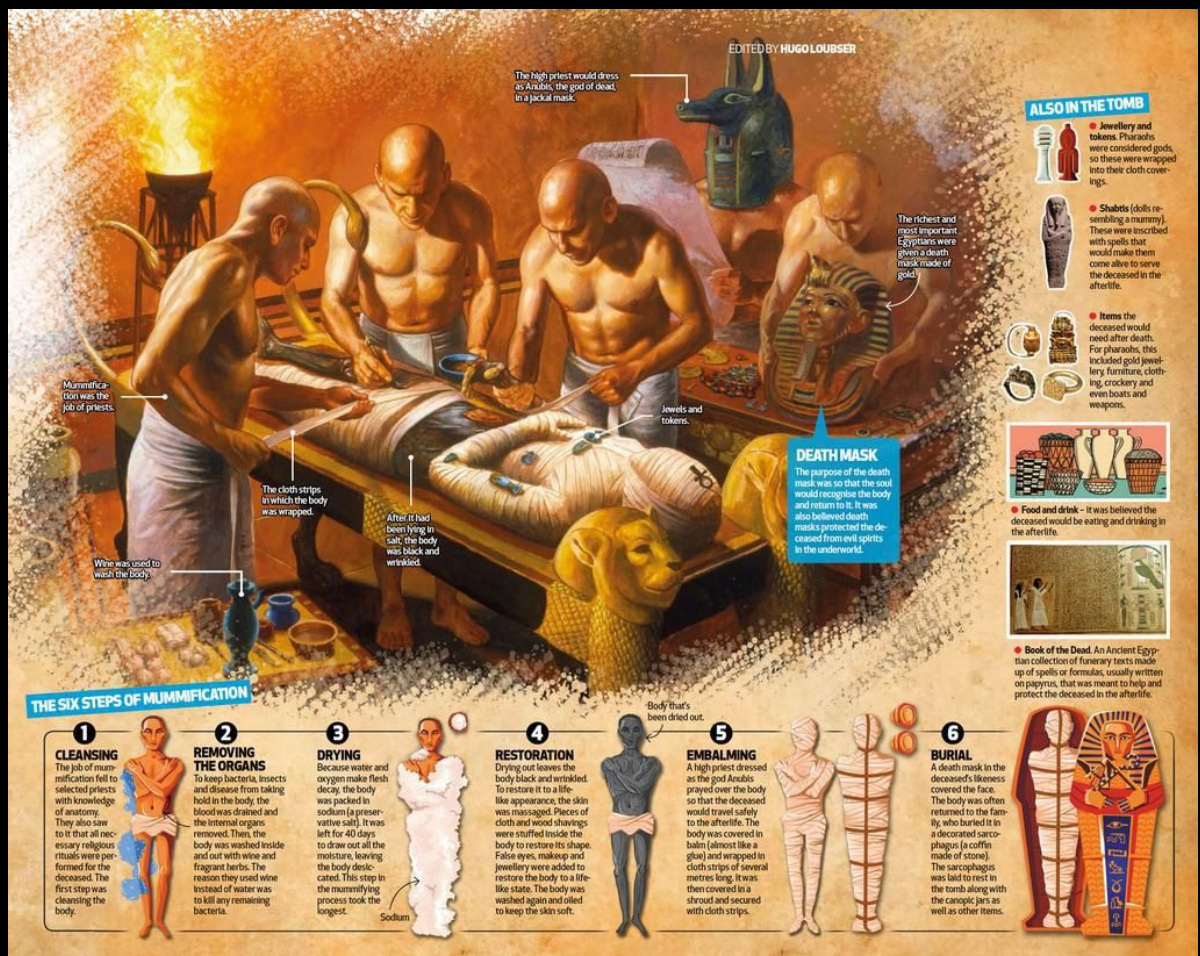

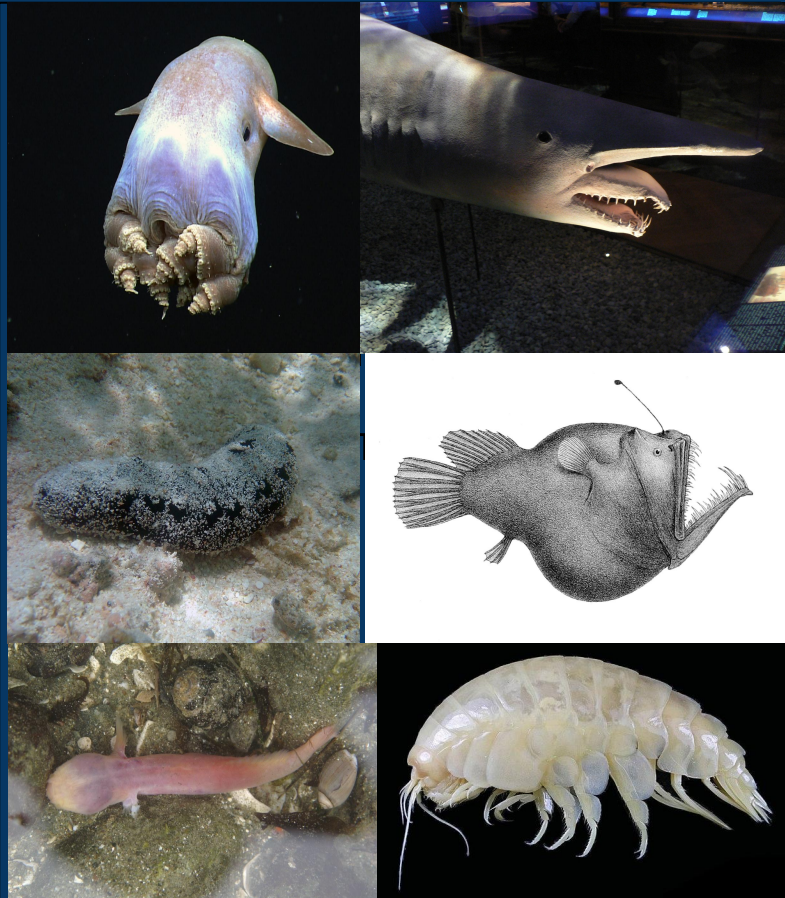

How big is the ocean?

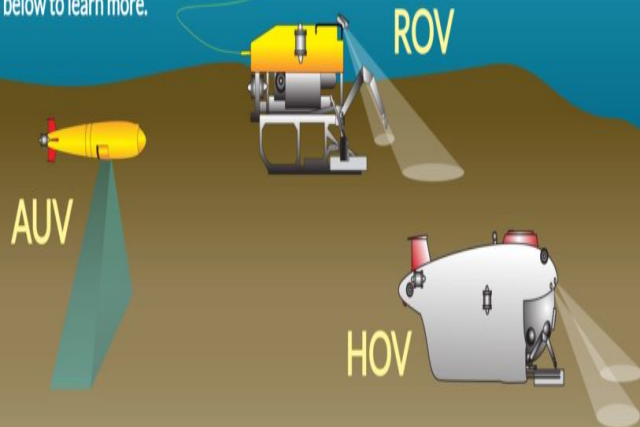
The ocean, which we often break into five large ocean basins, covers 71 percent of the earth's surface and holds **over 1.3 cubic km of water**. The ocean has an average depth of approximately 3.7 kilometres (or 2.3 miles). A calculation from satellite measurements in 2010 put the average depth at 3,682 metres (12,080 feet). However, at the time only 10% of earth's ocean had been mapped to high resolution, so this figure is only an estimate.



Underwater Research Vehicles

Since the 1960's three basic types of exploration vehicles have been developed, and they all remain in use today. Each type has its own role in ocean research and they often support or complement each other's capabilities.

How deep can people go in the ocean?

The maximum depth reached by anyone in a single breath is 702 feet (213.9 meters) and this record was set in 2007 by Herbert Nitsch. He also holds the record for the deepest dive without oxygen-reaching the depth of 831 feet (253.2 meters) but he sustained a brain injury as he was ascending. Scientists haven't yet determined a hard limit for how deep we can survive underwater. There have been a few instances of divers surviving ridiculous depths (not without side effects), but most professional free divers don't go past 400 feet deep.
